To the Honorable Judge:

We respectfully introduce **The Foundation of Change**, a federally recognized Section 501(c)(3) public charity (EIN: 33-5003265) established to provide structured, court-compatible community service programming for individuals appearing before the courts.

The Foundation of Change was built as a true accountability partner to the judicial system - a platform the court can audit, verify, and rely on as a trusted extension of its alternative sentencing authority. We do not ask the court to accept a printed certificate on faith alone.

Every certified hour submitted to the court enforces the following compliance mechanisms:

- 1. Identity & Court Verification:** At enrollment, each participant creates a verified account with their full legal name and email address, permanently attaching all completion records to the individual.
- 2. Window Blur & Tab Visibility:** Active engagement is mandatory. Our environment actively monitors browser focus, immediately pausing the time-tracker if a participant minimizes the window or alt-tabs to a different tab, coupled with a strict 10-minute AFK timeout.
- 3. Multi-Tab Blocks & Daily Caps:** Our platform utilizes override protocols to prohibit users from opening multiple coursework tabs simultaneously, and enforces an 8-hour maximum daily throttle to eliminate artificial "speed-running".
- 4. Time-Locked & Qualitative Assessments:** Reflection text forms remain physically locked until the individual spends the analytically required reading time for each module. We enforce strict character-count minimums and actively disable clipboard copy/pasting to verify genuine cognitive engagement.

Program Curriculum: Our coursework is rooted in evidence-based Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) and Restorative Justice principles. Participants complete structured modules across topics including Anger Management, Addiction Awareness, Domestic Violence Prevention, Emotional Intelligence & Mental Health, Personal Accountability, Civic Responsibility, Crime Prevention, Life Skills & Decision Making, and Personal Development & Rehabilitation. Each module requires active reading with mandatory written reflections demonstrating genuine comprehension — not passive screen time.

THE VERIFICATION PORTAL

Any judge, district attorney, or court clerk may visit thefoundationofchange.org/certificate-verification or scan the QR code to securely pull the raw, server-side Hour Logs - confirming exact localized timestamps and coursework completion records for any participant, at any time, without contacting our office.



We remain fully at the disposal of the court. Our IRS determination letter, Candid Platinum Transparency verification, and complete programmatic documentation are available upon request and may be attached to this letter for the court's permanent records.
